Protocol for Grangemouth Seafarers Centre

The Grangemouth Seafarer Centre will open 24/7 effective 17/7/20 at 9.30am. There is, however, a strict protocol in place.

IT IS INCUMBENT ON EACH INDIVIDUAL DISPLAYING ANY SYMPTOMS OF CORONAVIRUS (a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste) NOT TO ENTER THE CENTRE AND CONTACT NHS Scotland or Forth Port Authorities

Protection within the premises

- 1. We have in place a fogging process (Zoono) that will be applied every 28 days. It will be applied professionally by a fogging/misting process, this not only offers Coronavirus protection for premises, but reassurance for visitors to the centre. The application is suitable for all surfaces, fabrics and skin, providing up to 30 days surface protection and 24 hrs on skin & 100 washes on fabric. (It is not removed by hand washing and wears off only by skin exfoliation). Zoono is also an organic, chemical-free, non-toxic, food safe, child safe, colourless and environmentally-friendly product.
- 2. The centre is operating under a '1m separation between individuals' basis
- 3. We have a computerised login and logout station at the entrance that we require <u>all</u> visitors to complete with: Name, Ship, Mobile number, Time in and Time out.
- 4. Beside the sign-in computer we have a hand sanitising station that we require all visitors to use **immediately after** signing in.



5. All visitors must wear a face covering of any type, which covers nose and mouth.

- 6. All visitors must remain a minimum of 1m apart.
- 7. On departing, all visitors must sign out and then **immediately use the hand sanitiser**.
- 8. Only disposable cups and paper towels will be available within the centre.
